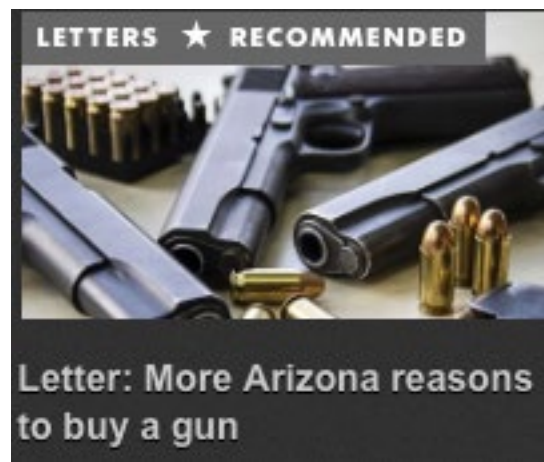


Should I buy a gun?
